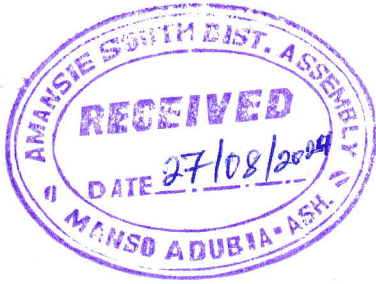

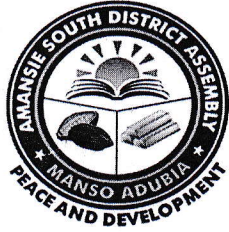

ORIENTATION OF FOOD VENDORS AND CATERERS IN ADUBIA

The Environmental Health and Sanitation Unit and the school feeding coordinator on Thursday August 21st 2024 organized a one day sensitization program for food vendors and school feeding caterers in the district.

VENUE: Adubia Assembly hall.

FACILITATORS: Environmental Health Officer and School Health Education Programme Coordinator.

PARTICIPANTS: 61

FOODVENDORS: 35

SCHOOL FEEDING CATERERS: 26

NUMBER OF MALES: 6

NUMBER OF FEMALES: 55

The reason behind the exercise was to give them orientation on the following;

- ✓ Personal hygiene.
- ✓ Environmental Sanitation
- ✓ Food safety
- ✓ Nutritionally improved and well balanced diet food for general public and school pupils in the district.
- ✓ Importance of medical screening.

Most of the illness many Ghanaians suffer is as a result of the dirty surroundings we live in and disregards for personal hygiene, nutritional defects and unbalanced

food also contribute on the greater part, negatively to our health. This therefore made the orientation very important and timely.

They were also sensitized on the need to undergo the yearly food vendor's medical screening exercise, as this will go a long way to enhance their health status against preventable but communicable infections. They were encouraged to take advantage of the mass food vendor's medical screening which was slated to start on the 2nd of September 2024.

Almost all the vendors expressed concerns about the difficulties faced in accessing credit facilities. They were therefore calling the district assembly to assist them secure loans from the banks. The caterers bemoaned government inability to pay them for months. The school feeding coordinator assured them that, plans were far advanced to address their concerns.
